1. Essays must be at least 3,000 and not more than 6,000 words, inclusive of footnotes or endnotes.
2. Essays must be in Microsoft Word format.
3. Essays submitted for consideration must be researched and written by one author.
4. Essays must be submitted to Randi Glass, Executive Director by email at randi@cdlawyers.org
5. The author's name and law school should be noted on the front page of the essay but must not be shown on any other pages of the essay.
6. Submissions of an essay implies that it is the author's own original, unpublished work. **Papers submitted for a law school course are eligible and encouraged.**
7. The winning essay may be published by Canadian Defence Lawyers in a suitable venue.
